**Covid-19**

A go4awalk "Wild Walk" taking in eight summits, the highest being Aran Fawddwy (a Hewitt, a Nutall and a Marilyn) at 905m it is the highest point in Wales south of Snowdon. Hopefully with glorious views while being gloriously quiet.
